应用场景：日常学习

教学目标与知识点：了解 OA 的定义，知晓主要的 OA 资源检索平台。能从 OA 信息资源检索系统 DOAJ、OALIB 等 OA 资源检索平台上进行文献检索。

案例正文

如何获取 ScienceDirect 中的 OA 期刊信息？在不具备收费全文数据的访问权限的情况下，如何下载论文全文。

分析思路

Open Access (简称 OA) 资源是指由同行评审的期刊论文、学术会议论文以及技术报告、学位论文和工作论文共同组成的资源。“Open Access” 是指“可以在公共因特网上免费地获取文献，允许任何用户阅读、下载、复制、发布、打印和查找，或者提供对这些论文文本的链接、对他们进行索引、将它们作为素材纳入软件、以及其它任何法律许可的应用。

常用的 OA 检索平台有 DOAJ、OALIB、Socolar 等。除了 OA 检索平台外，数据库商也将部分期刊作为 OA 期刊共用户免费阅读和下载。

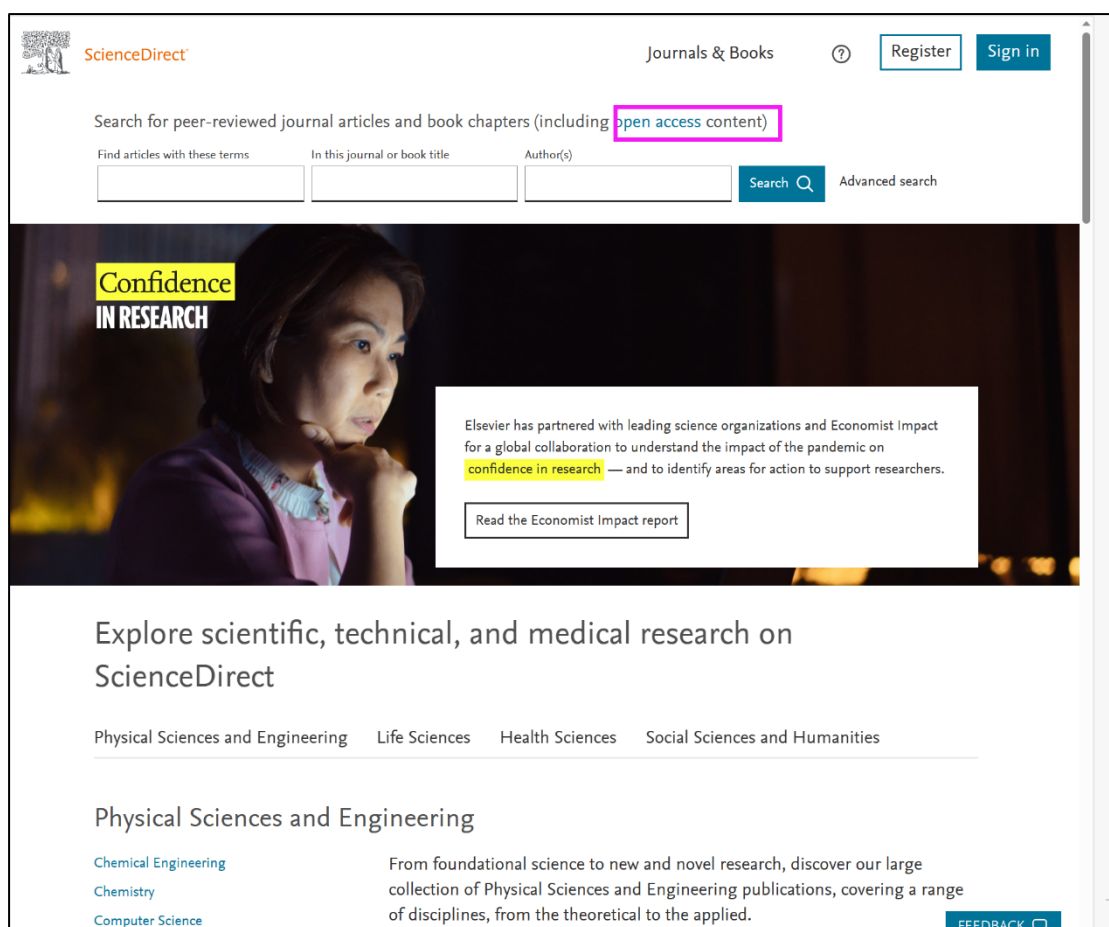
检索策略

问题 1 的检索策略。

ScienceDirect 是 Elsevier 公司的全文数据库，该数据库的使用购买使用。要获取 ScienceDirect 中的 OA 期刊信息，可以通过访问 ScienceDirect 网站获取。

首先，进入 ScienceDirect 网站 <https://www.sciencedirect.com/>

进入网站后，可以浏览该网站提供的 open access content 相关内容。这部分操作无 IP 或账号限制，读者可以通过互联网进行访问。



点击 open access content 连接后，可以获知 ScienceDirect 数据库中的全 OA 期刊和图书，以及部分内容 OA 的期刊。

Articles published open access are peer-reviewed and made freely available for everyone to read, download and reuse in line with the user license displayed on the article.

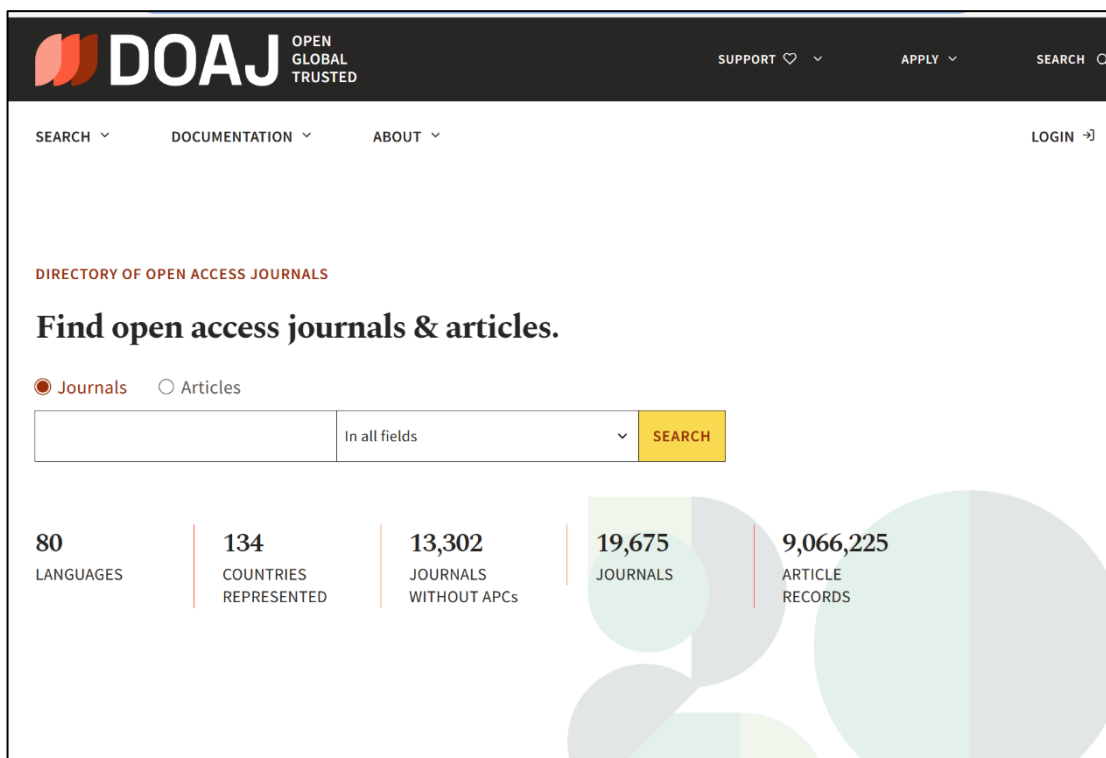

本案例以为 DOAJ，检索标题含有 solid waste（固体废物）的论文为例。

首先进入 DOAJ 网站，<https://www.doaj.org/>



第二步，选择 Articles，输入检索词“solid waste”，检索字段选择 Title



第三步, 可通过检索结果的左侧的提炼检索选线对检索结果进行筛选。点击“read online”即可获得访问全文的链接。
